NEW – Mandatory Quality Assurance and Ethics Training. Beginning January 1, 2019 all junior livestock (large and small animal) exhibitors will be required to participate in a Quality Assurance and Ethics Training. Currently, the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) online program has been approved by F&E to fulfill this requirement. **Visit www.yqca.org and click Sign In/Register at the top of the page. Training must be complete prior to exhibitor arriving at the Fair.**

SHOW ENTRY INFORMATION ~

1. This is a one- (1) day carry in cage show. All carrying cages must have waterproof bottoms. All best of breeds must stay for best of show. If you can't stay please notify the show secretary.
2. The entry fee is \$3.00 per Cavy. Showmanship is an additional \$3.00. Make checks payable to the Cloverdale Citrus Fair. Check or money order must accompany entry form. (There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks.) Entry fees are non-refundable.
3. No phone entries or day of show entries will be accepted. STATE RULE: Substitutions can only be made within a section. Substitutions must be made when the exhibit arrives at the fairgrounds. A minimum \$5 penalty must be paid prior to judging for each substitution made by the exhibitor in excess of two in the section.

CAVY CLASSIFICATIONS

Senior Boar - over 32 oz.

Intermediate Boar - Animals up to 6 months or age, or weight over 22 oz. and up to and including 32 oz.

JUNIOR CAVY SHOW (continued)

Junior Boar - Animals up to 4 months of age, minimum weight of 12 oz., maximum weight of 22 oz.

Senior Sow - Over 32 oz.

Intermediate Sow - Animals up to 6 months of age, or weight over 22 oz. and up to and including 32 oz.

Junior Sow - Animals up to 4 months of age, minimum weight of 12 oz., maximum weight of 22 oz.
