**NEW – Mandatory Quality Assurance and Ethics Training.** Beginning January 1, 2019 all junior livestock (large and small animal) exhibitors will be required to participate in a Quality Assurance and Ethics Training. Currently, the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) online program has been approved by F&E to fulfill this requirement. **Visit [www.yqca.org](http://www.yqca.org) and click Sign In/Register at the top of the page. Training must be complete prior to exhibitor arriving at the Fair.**

### SHOW ENTRY INFORMATION ~

Animals must be entered in individual classes to qualify for showmanship. Fee is \$4.00 per dog. \$3.00 for Showmanship.

Animals must be owned by exhibitor for at least 90 days prior to the day of show. Limit of one dog per exhibitor.

Exhibitor/dog are allowed to enter only one Obedience class and one Showmanship class.

**ENTRY FORM IN THE MIDDLE OF THIS GUIDEBOOK.**

### SHOW RULES:

1. Open to all Juniors who are regularly enrolled in a structured dog care and training project exhibiting a dog (mixed or purebred) that is owned by the exhibitor or immediate family.
2. Dog must be 6 months or older.
3. Dog must have been trained and fitted by exhibitor only.
4. Dogs may be shown by only one exhibitor and may not be shared within families.
5. Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete. Uncontrolled or aggressive dogs will not be allowed to show.
6. Judging will be done American Style. **THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.**
7. This is a Junior show age 5 through 19. All exhibitors must wear their official uniform while showing (4-H, FFA). Independent Juniors must wear white ankle length pants and white shirt.
8. Exhibitors are responsible for entering and showing their dog in the right class.
9. Fair management reserves the right to limit entries based on the time available for judging.

### DIVISION ~ 6000 Obedience

#### CLASSES

1. **Sub-Novice A:** First year exhibitor, first year dog. All exercises on a six foot leash. Heel and figure eight, stand for examination, recall, long sit (one minute), and long down (three minutes).
2. **Sub-Novice B:** 2. Exhibitor who has previously competed in Obedience showing a new dog. New dog must not have shown previously. All exercises on a six foot leash. Heel and figure eight, stand for examination, recall, long sit (one minute), and long down (three minutes).
3. **Sub-Novice C:** Third year exhibitor or higher and any dog not ready to go off leash. All exercises on a six foot leash. Heel and figure eight, stand for examination, recall, long sit (one minute), and long down (three minutes).
4. **Novice:** For third year and over dogs or any first or second year dog that has received a qualifying score in Novice Obedience at any dog show. Heel and figure eight on leash. Heel, stand for examination, recall, long sit (one minute), and long down (three minutes) off leash.
5. **Graduate Novice:** Heel on leash. Stand for examination, heel and figure eight off leash, drop on recall, long sit and long down (five minutes) out of sight.

## JUNIOR DOG SHOW (continued)

### AWARDS ~

#### 1. Obedience Division:

- A. Five (5) highest scoring competitors in each Obedience Class receive 1st. through 5th Place Rosettes.
- B. High in Trial on Leash Trophy – highest score from Sub-Novice A, B, C.
- C. High in Trail Off Leash Trophy – highest score from Novice and Graduate Novice.

#### 2. Showmanship Division:

- A. 1st through 8th Place Rosettes. First Place Winner will receive an Award.
- B. Best Junior Handler Award: Each first place winner from all the Showmanship classes will return to the ring to compete for overall Showmanship winner.

**NOTE:** The first and second place Junior (aged 9 – 13 Years), and Senior (aged 14 – 18 Years) winners in Showmanship are eligible to compete in Small Animal Round Robin Monday, February 19, 1PM. The First and Second place Showmanship winners from Junior 9-11 yrs. And Intermediate 12-13 yrs. will return to the ring to determine the 2 winners who will advance to Junior Small Animal Round Robin. Notify the Livestock Superintendent if you are unable.

### SHOW RULES ~

1. Open to 4-H, FFA and Grange members placing 1st or 2nd in their showmanship class, Junior classes 9-13 years old, Senior classes 14-19.
  2. Exhibitor may only show the animal with which they won their showmanship class. Any exception must be cleared through the Round Robin Superintendent.
  3. If an exhibitor has qualified in more than one species, no other exhibitor will be considered to replace him/her to participate in the Round Robin Contest.
  4. Exhibitors will be scored individually by the judge on a scale of 1-10 points. The score is based on how well they show the assigned animal and on how well they answer the questions asked by the judge.
  5. A maximum of 5 minutes will be allowed for showmanship in each species.
  6. You must let the office know if you are unable to participate in the Round Robin.
  7. A member who has qualified in FFA, 4-H and Grange has a choice of whether they want to show in FFA , 4-H or Grange, but not in all.
  8. In the event of a tie between two or more exhibitors the tie will be broken in this order:
    - a. The exhibitor with the highest score on the species that qualified them for Round Robin. If the exhibitor qualified in more than one animal, it will be the exhibitor's choice as to which score to use.
    - b. The exhibitor with the most consistent set of scores.
- Example:

| Exhibitor #2 | 7 | 8 | 8  | 7 | = | 30 |
- Exhibitor #2 would be the winner.
9. Each exhibitor will be required to show each of the following: Poultry, Rabbit, Cavy, Dog, and Pygmy Goat.
