2020 RULES

CLOVERDALE CITRUS FAIR PRINCESS PROGRAM

1. The 2019 Cloverdale Citrus Fair Princess Program will be presented on Friday, February 15, in the Citrus Fair Auditorium.
2. To be eligible for participation, an applicant:
 - a. Must be a resident of Cloverdale Township, which includes Geyserville, for at least one year prior to February 14, 2020.
 - b. Must be between 6 and 14 years of age, currently enrolled in school.
 - c. Contestant will participate in a dance performance during the Queen pageant.
3. Contestant must wear appropriate dress attire for performance.
4. Once sponsorship funds have been received by the Citrus Fair, contestant will be reimbursed \$50 to help defray expenses.
5. First ten applications per age group will be accepted. New applicants will be given priority. Previous participants will be entered on a waiting list.
